- **3** Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4 Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Colleges by getting an Associate degree.
- **5** Transfer to SUNY Albany to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
- **6** Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from SUNY Albany!

## TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS FOR SUNY ALBANY:

- **1** Earn the equivalent of an Associate's degree with a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, including transferrable credit from all previous institutions.
- 2 Meet English Proficiency by completing English Composition I and II with a minimum 2.0 grade.
- **3** Apply as a Transfer Student www.albany.edu and provide official copies of all transcripts.
- **4** Adhere to The University at Albany, State University of New York's deadlines for application and document submission, and admission policies.
- **5** Upon admission, submit all required documents for F-1 student status and SEVIS transfer.

Please note admission into a specific academic program is not guaranteed and is dependent on specific program admission requirements and capacity. We look forward to welcoming you to The University at Albany, State University of New York.
