When you apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from University of Alaska Fairbanks – even before you leave your home country!

HERE'S HOW EASY IT IS!

- 1 Apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, indicating your transfer preference to University of Alaska Fairbanks on your application.
- 2 Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Colleges, and a conditional letter of admission from University of Alaska Fairbanks, at the same time.
- 3 Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- **4** Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Colleges by getting an Associate degree, completing the required SCD courses for your intended UAF program.
- **5** Transfer to University of Alaska Fairbanks to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
- **6** Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from University of Alaska Fairbanks!

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS FOR UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA FAIRBANKS:

- 1 Complete an approved transferable Associate degree at Seattle Colleges, including the courses required for your intended UAF degree program (consult with your academic advisor upon enrollment at Seattle Colleges for a complete list).
- **2** Submit an approved form of proof of English Proficiency, e.g., completion of ENGL& 101 with a grade of at least 2.00, official TOEFL iBT score of 79 and above, or an IELTS score of 6.5 and above.
- **3** Earn a minimum 2.00 cumulative grade point average on all transferable credit classes from Seattle Central College and previous institutions.
- **4** Submit an admission application online at https://uaonline.alaska.edu. Note that the University of Alaska Fairbanks will waive its \$50 application fee for all Seattle Colleges students who have a transfer admission guarantee letter.
- **5** Send official copies of all transcripts, financial statement, and suporting documentation to the UAF Office of Admissions.
- **6** Adhere to University of Alaska Fairbanks' deadlines for application and document submission, and admission policies.
- 7 Upon admission, submit all required documents for F1 student status and SEVIS transfer.
